Recommendations for Event Organisers

1. All events must be recorded for the Agile 20 Reflect Festival Archive
2. Videos will be published on YouTube with a Creative Commons license on the Agile20reflect Channel. Event organisers and speakers agree to supply a video recording of their event for the Festival Archive. Please email archiving@agile20reflect.org to arrange a transfer of your file within 3 days of the event.
3. All event attendees should be made aware of the recording, and allowed to turn off their video if they do not want to be seen on YouTube
4. When carrying out activities during talks, participation by attendees is voluntary; everyone has the right to pass
5. Event Organisers or Speakers, please, when opening an event, say: "We want to make you aware that the Agile 20 Reflect Festival has a Code of Conduct, that essentially requires all event participants, whether speakers or attendees, to treat each other with respect and kindness. We hope this is the case. In the interest of upholding this Code, if you have any concerns, please let the host know, and if that does not resolve the concern please email EventsConduct@Agile20reflect.org."
